Recognizing and commending His Royal Majesty King Muja'Dib Jamel El'Sori-Oser VIII; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, His Royal Majesty King Muja'Dib Jamel El'Sori-Oser VIII, the sovereign of the Kingdom of Numidoria, is an eighth-generation monarch whose lineage traces to HRH Prince Abdul Rahman Soir, whose legacy he has reclaimed to restore African sovereignty and unity; and

WHEREAS, he has dedicated his leadership to advancing Africa's economic transformation, the reintegration of the African diaspora, and the reclamation of the continent's wealth and resources, with an emphasis on empowerment, infrastructure development, and cultural revival; and

WHEREAS, as founder of Numi Kingdom Global Enterprise Corp. (NKGE Corp.), valued at \$500 million, he oversees ventures including SMENTAP Gold Mining, CETS Global Corp., and Frerox Communication Ltd., with investments in banking, trade, smart cities, and resource management across Africa, the Middle East, and beyond; and

WHEREAS, his royal authority includes the establishment of the Kingdom Trust to safeguard crown assets, economic infrastructure, and royal governance, as well as territorial development in East Africa, Sudan, and North Sudan aimed at creating a sovereign African economic hub; and

WHEREAS, his initiatives include the creation of a \$2 billion sovereign insurance policy backed by gold and land assets as well as the negotiation of trade agreements positioning Numidoria as a significant player in African and global markets; and

WHEREAS, His Royal Majesty King Muja'Dib Jamel El'Sori-Oser VIII has been an advocate for recognition of the Sixth Region within the African Union, building alliances with international and intergovernmental organizations, and collaborating with traditional kingdoms to restore Africa's cultural and economic autonomy; and

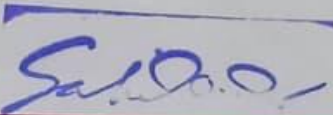

- WHEREAS,** His Royal Majesty King Muja'Dib Jamel El' Osiri, born John S. Wise III on June 2, 1965, in Jacksonville, Florida, demonstrated exceptional academic prowess, excelling in Math at the University of South Florida, majoring in Fine Arts and Business; and
- WHEREAS,** King Jamel's journey included the study of religion under esteemed mentors, becoming an Ordained Associate Pastor at Mount Zion Baptist Church and delving into Biblical teachings and history, earning the honor of valedictorian; and
- WHEREAS,** Embracing his national identity as a Washita Moor under the tutelage of Grand Sheikh Coleman El, he transformed into Prince Jamel El Osiris, studying radiology at Universal Fortis and founding Nu Moorish International Group of Science and Development Under Common Law (NUMI) alongside his wife, Queen Saidah; and

The Numi Kingdom of the Fulani Realm, under the Royal House of Muja'Dib El Sori, asserts its sovereignty in accordance with customary international law. This sovereignty is recognized under the framework of the United Nations Diplomatic Relations (Preamble, Article 47.1) and the UN Consular Relations, which affirm that a sovereign "subject of international law" is binding upon all states, irrespective of formal recognition (UN Law, Article 17.1). As a non-territorial state, the Numi Kingdom operates within the provisions of the UN Diplomatic Relations (Articles 1(i) and 3.1(a)). It is established as the "Kingdom" of the African Diaspora and Numidia people, a designation supported by the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP, Articles 3, 4, 5, 9, 33, 36, and 37). The Numidia people, recognized as an indigenous ethnic and spiritual community, are further protected under international law, as affirmed by the Great Seal National Association of Cultural Affairs (2019, p.11) and UNDRIP Article 8. This preamble affirms the sovereignty, rights, and international legal standing of the Numi Kingdom, guided by the enduring principles of equity, self-determination, and cultural preservation under the framework of international law.
